

Job Opportunity Sherwood Forest Road Superintendent

The Sherwood Forest Road Maintenance District (SFRMD) is accepting applications for the position of Road Superintendent. This is a part-time salaried position with an annual compensation of \$6,400.

The District's Road Superintendent is under the direct supervision of the Prudential Committee and is responsible for all aspects of the districts approximately 20 mile of gravel/dirt roads and related infrastructure.

The applicant must have demonstrable training; education and experience in the field to clearly establish that the candidate possess the requisite knowledge, skills and abilities needed for public works road maintenance and construction. Experience in maintaining improved and unimproved gravel/dirt roads, associated waterways, ditches and culverts found in Berkshire County, is fundamental along with a minimum of three (3) years supervisory experience in working with contractors and on occasion engineers.

The Road Superintendent must be able to easily communicate with the committee and its appointed designee, as well as work cooperatively with all contractors, and proprietors. Additionally the Road Superintendent as a highly visible face of the District needs to project a positive image within the community and to the public at large.

The District' Road Superintendent must possess a valid Massachusetts driver's license and live within 12 miles of Sherwood Forest.
